
## III. Sejong Korean courses Curriculum

1. Capacity on the class: 3~7people

2. Tuition & Text book fee: free

3. Korean language course period: August 8<sup>th</sup>~November 7<sup>th</sup>(4months)

4. Text Book: Sejong1~8 levels, Sejong Korean conversation 4levels



5. Class schedule: Twice a week(Mon&Wed or Tue&Thu)

6. Time: 3hours per a course

7. Level test: Necessary 2ways(in person interview and Sejong online level test)

- Take a 10 minutes(in person interview)

- After selecting, inform the interview schedule via e-mail

8. Assigning class: According to the level test result

- 9. Off-line Class Contents: Korean speaking, writing, reading, listening
- 10. On-line Class content: Focusing on improving Korean Speaking
- 11. Korean cultural experience is part of the class(2times)
